How the colour palette is defined












The colour palette has two main colour sets, called **Brand 1** and **Brand 2**. Each of the colour sets are generated from one of your main brand colours.

Each colour set has a brand colour (the **key colour variant**), as well as two lighter variants, and one darker.

A set of neutral and semantic colours are also included in the palette. Dark error and success colours should only be used for inline validation.
